If you provide us with your personal information, you have the right to access your information and receive copies of it. Also, you can ask for your data to be corrected, if it is incomplete or inaccurate, you can request the data’s deletion or limitation of its processing. You also have the right to object to the processing, as well as to file a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Commission.

**The Website uses cookies**

Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer when you visit the Website and help make a connection between the Website and your computer.

***The Website uses only absolutely necessary cookies.*** These cookies insure that the Website will function properly and allow us to perform functions, requested by you. These cookies provide you with the option to select a language on the Website, fill in the fields in the contact form and open a specific section of the Website. These cookies are essential for the security of the Website and make it possible for the company, which is responsible for the maintenance of the Website, to get alerts about issues with the Website (e.g. inability to load, inability to allow entries, etc.). Cookies are deleted as soon as you close your browser.

If our Website refers you to another website via a link, be aware that we are not responsible for the cookies, used by other websites, and we encourage you to familiarize yourself with their policies.
